

RESOLUTION APPROVING ASSESSMENT NO. 2505

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council on date of
February 23rd, 1945

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of the City of Sacramento has heretofore made and issued and filed with the City Clerk an Assessment, together with a Diagram and Engineer's Certificate, to represent the costs and expenses of improving the westerly side of 43rd Street from 14th Avenue northerly 128.5 feet and the northerly side of 14th Avenue from the easterly line of 42nd Street to the westerly line of 43rd Street, in the City of Sacramento

in the City of Sacramento, the proceedings for the making of which improvement were initiated by the adoption of Resolution of Intention No. 2505;

WHEREAS, this is the time fixed by the City Clerk for the hearing by this Council upon said Assessment; and it is also the time fixed for the hearing of any appeal to this Council by any person interested in said work or in said Assessment; and

WHEREAS, no appeal has been taken to this Council by any person, and the City Council has heard evidence upon said Assessment and the Diagram and Engineer's Certificate attached thereto, and is satisfied with the correctness of the same;

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that said Assessment, together with the Diagram and Engineer's Certificate attached thereto, be, and the same are, hereby confirmed and approved in all respects as filed.
