

ORDINANCE NO. 1620, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE CERTAIN CONSTRUCTION AND PAVING MATERIALS FOR GRADING, PAVING, AND DRAINAGE OF THE OFF-STREET PARKING PROJECT, AND TO HAVE THE WORK DONE BY CITY FORCES WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase in the open market without first advertising for bids, certain construction and paving materials for the grading, paving, and drainage, for the installation of off-street parking facilities in the blocks 6th and 7th, L and Capitol Avenue, and 10th and 11th, H & I, excepting the North 40 feet of Lot 8 thereof, not being a part of the project, and to have this work done by city forces, all pursuant to the provisions of Section 251 of the City Charter.

SECTION 2: That said work shall include also the removal and replacing of portions of the sidewalks, curbs, and gutters abutting the said project, also electrical work and materials for lighting of the area within the project. That the estimated cost of completion of this work is \$60,000.

SECTION 3: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the immediate necessity of completing work of grading, paving, and drainage of the area within and abutting the off-street parking project before the advent of the rainy season and to complete the project for public use, safety, and convenience of the citizens of the City of Sacramento at the earliest possible date.
