SUBJECT: STATUS OF DEVELOPMENT OF CHILD CARE ORDINANCE

This is a second in a series of brief status reports on the development of a Child Care Ordinance for the City of Sacramento.

The last update report was provided on October 16, 1987. Since that date several additional meetings have been held by City staff to obtain more information from other cities as well as to conduct research on child care needs. The needs assessment will serve as a basis for the need and justification for having a City Child Care Ordinance.

In terms of a schedule outline for bringing a proposed ordinance forward for consideration by the Transportation and Community Development Committee, the following has been developed:

January, 1988

Complete child care needs assessment and implement child care survey.

February, 1988

City staff works with developers, child care community as well as Sacramento County and SHRA representatives on general parameters of proposed ordinance.

March, 1988


Draft Child Care Ordinance provided to Transportation and Community Development Committee.
