

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 2429

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, the public interest and convenience require that the work and improvement hereinafter described should be done;

NOW, THEREFORE, the said City Council of the City of Sacramento does hereby resolve and declare that it is the intention of said City Council to order the following work and improvement to be done in said City, to-wit:

To close, vacate and abandon the following described street:

14th Street from the southerly line of Robertson Way to the southerly boundary of "Land Drive Terrace Unit No. 2", (as the same is shown on the official map or plat thereof filed in the office of the Recorder of Sacramento County, California).

And said City Council does hereby determine and declare that said proposed work and improvement is of more than local or ordinary public benefit, and will affect and benefit the lands and district hereinafter described, and which said district is hereby declared to be the district affected and benefited by said work and improvement, and that therefore the entire damages, costs and expenses of said work and improvement shall be and are hereby made chargeable against, and shall be assessable upon, said lands and district, which district is within the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California; and the exterior boundaries of the lands affected and benefited by said work and improvement are particularly described as follows, to-wit:

On the north by Robertson Way; on the south by the southerly boundary of the said "Land Drive Terrace Unit No. 2"; on the east by the easterly line of Lot 140 in said tract; and on the west by the westerly line of Lot 139 in said tract.

All of the said work and improvement shall be done in accordance with the provisions of the act of the legislature of the State of California entitled "An Act to Provide for the Laying out, Opening, Extending, Widening, Straightening or Closing up in whole or in part any Street, Square, Lane, Alley, Court or Place Within Municipalities and to Condemn and Acquire any and all land and Property necessary or convenient for that purpose," approved March 6, 1889, and the several acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto.


The Street Superintendent is hereby directed to cause notices of the passage of this resolution to be printed and posted in accordance with law, and to cause a notice similar in substance to be published in the "Sacramento Union," a daily newspaper published and circulated in the said City of Sacramento, all as prescribed by law.
