SUBJECT: Report on Bids for GLENWOOD PARK AND NINOS PARK COMFORT STATIONS

SUMMARY:

The subject project, as part of the City's Capital Improvement program, has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the City Engineer recommends that this report be filed and that all bids be rejected.

BACKGROUND:

On May 8, 1980, the City Council approved plans and specifications for the subject project and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on May 27, 1980. The bids received are as follows:

Bambery Construction Co.	\$ 82,522.00
Kimmel Construction, Inc.	98,860.00
Zenith Construction, Inc.	116,564.00

The engineer's estimate for this project was \$64,200.00. Since the bid is 28.54% above the engineer's estimate, we feel it is in the best interest of the City to reject all bids.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that this report be filed and that all bids be rejected.
