

# RESOLUTION No. 256

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

October 1, 1943

WHEREAS: On the 12th day of June, 1942, the City of Sacramento entered into a contract with the Sanitary Disposal Company for the disposal of garbage, according to a schedule which enumerated cans among other things; and

WHEREAS, shortly thereafter the United States Government required that all cans be delivered to firms or agencies designated by it, as a part of the war effort; and

WHEREAS, by reason of the failure of the City to deliver cans to said company, said company has a claim against the City for breach of contract; and

WHEREAS, said failure to deliver cans will exist as long as the United States Government requires said cans to be delivered to firms or agencies designated by it; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the company and the City Engineer have figured that a just compensation to the company for such failure is 32% of the amount paid by the United States Government, or its designated firms or agencies, to the City for cans delivered,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that until further order, the City pay to said company 32% of each collection made from the United States Government, or its designated firms or agencies, for cans delivered to it or them by the City.
