RESOLUTION SUSPENDING COMPETITIVE BIDDING TO PERMIT USE OF THE SHELTERED MARKET APPROACH FOR SOLICITATION OF FORMAL BIDS FOR TRUCKING SERVICES; AND AUTHORIZATION TO EXTEND EXISTING TRUCKING SERVICE AGREEMENTS IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$130,000

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

1. In the best interests of the City, as set forth in the staff report for this item, competitive bidding is suspended for the procurement of Trucking Services for the Department of Utilities and the Department of Transportation.
2. The Procurement Services Manager is authorized to use the sheltered market approach to solicit bids from small and/or emerging businesses for these Trucking Services.
3. The Procurement Services Manager is authorized to extend the existing Trucking Services contracts with Bob's Trucking and D & N Associates for a period not to exceed 90 days, in a total amount not to exceed \$130,000.
