

RESOLUTION No. 130

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

December 4, 1942

AUTHORIZING PETITION BY CITY FOR REMOVAL OF PUBLIC UTILITIES AND REQUESTING RELEASE TO CITY OF CERTAIN RIGHT-OF-WAYS

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Sacramento, that the City Manager is hereby directed to petition the Pacific Gas & Electric Company to remove power lines and poles which now exist in the road which lies along the northerly boundary of the "Moulton Tract," in the County of Sacramento, and running westerly from 24th Street to the property of Louis and Marie Zraggen, said power lines and poles being within the property to be purchased by the City of Sacramento for Airport expansion; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Pacific Gas & Electric Company be, and it is, hereby requested to release to the City of Sacramento two right-of-ways lying within the property of said Louis and Marie Zraggen, one having been conveyed to the Great Western Power Company by deed dated April 1, 1930, recorded in Book 304 of official records at page 156, and the other by deed to the Great Western Power Company dated March 1, 1930, recorded in Book 314 of official records at page 251, said right-of-ways lying within the property to be purchased by the City of Sacramento for the proposed Municipal Airport expansion.
