SACRAMENTO POLICE DEPARTMENT MEASURE U ADJUSTMENTS

BACKGROUND

- A. On March 12, 2013, the Sacramento City Council approved Resolution #2013-0081, appropriating \$1.5 million in Measure U resources to expedite the restoration of sworn staffing levels and fund the cost of background investigations, equipment and vehicles.
- B. The Sacramento Police Department (SPD) was unable to spend \$744,000 of the \$1.5 million prior to the close of Fiscal Year (FY) 2012/13. This funding reverted back to the Measure U fund balance.
- C. The SPD maintains an operational requirement to properly equip the additional sworn officers restored by Measure U funding. These requirements total \$744,000 and include the purchase of police officer equipment (\$621,000) and patrol vehicles (\$123,000).

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to transfer \$744,000 in Measure U funding from fund balance to the FY 2013/14 SPD Measure U Multi-Year Operating Project (180110200) for the purchase of sworn equipment (\$621,000) and patrol vehicles (\$123,000).
