AGREEMENT FOR INSURANCE BROKERAGE SERVICES

BACKGROUND

- A. The City utilizes insurance brokerage services to place a variety of commercial insurance policies to protect the City in situations of loss to insurable City assets and liability and workers' compensation claims and litigation. The insurance broker also provides programs through which the public can purchase special events insurance for the use of City facilities. This is a convenient and economical method for the public to obtain the necessary insurance to utilize City facilities. Additionally, the insurance broker provides advice on risk management related issues.
- B. A Request for Proposal was issued September 10, 2010 for insurance brokerage services. A four member committee of external and internal individuals selected Alliant Insurance Services, Inc. as the City's insurance broker.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute an agreement with Alliant Insurance Services for a term of thirty-six (36) months at an annual cost not to exceed \$120,000 for year one (1), \$125,000 for year two (2), \$130,000 for year three (3), and with the City's option to renew for two (2) twelve month periods at a cost not to exceed \$135,000 for the first renewal year and \$140,000 for the second renewal year. The total not to exceed amount is \$650,000. This amount is included in the risk management budget (fund 6502) and the corresponding expenditure budgets are established for the duration of the contract subject to funding through the annual budget process
