

Sacramento, California,

July 27, 1931.

The Civil Service Board of the City of Sacramento met in special session on the above date at seven-ten o'clock P. M. in the office of the Board, Room 106 City Hall, President Chenu presiding.

PRESENT: Commissioners Maloney, Weisman, and Chenu.
ABSENT : None.

The minutes of the meetings of July 2, 1931, and July 22, 1931, were read and approved as read.

Mr. J. C. Mc Dowell, an eligible on the list for Collector,, appeared before the Board relative to his being certified for temporary work and not receiving appointment. The Board explained to Mr. Mc Dowell the regulations governing the procedure.

A communication was received from the Civil Service Commission of the City and County of San Francisco, extending an invitation to the Civil Service Board of the City of Sacramento to be represented at the Assembly of Civil Service Commissioners of the United States and Canada to be held in San Francisco August 26, 27, 28, and 29th of this year.

Commissioner Weisman moved that the invitation extended be accepted and that the Secretary convey the Board's acceptance and appreciation to the San Francisco Commission. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Maloney. The vote was as follows:

Commissioner Maloney moved that all eligible lists existing and active as of March 19, 1931, be governed by Rule 4, Section 3,

The Board proceeded to review the examination papers of the candidates in the recent examination for Fuel Inspector. Upon completion of the review, the identity of the candidates was established. Thirty-two candidates were successful in the examination.

Commissioner Maloney moved that the Personal Fitness Test in connection with the examination for Fuel Inspectors be conducted Monday Evening, August 3, 1931, at 6:00 o'clock P. M. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Weisman, and the vote was as follows:
