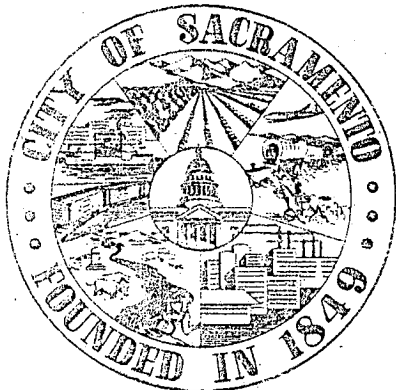

Recognizing Mary Louise Flint

WHEREAS, Mary Louise Flint, Extension Entomologist for the Department of Entomology and Director of Integrated Pest Management (IPM) Education and Publications, UC Statewide IPM Project at the University of California, Davis is to be recognized for her protection of local creeks, lakes, and rivers through her partnership in the development and implementation of the Sacramento Water Wise Pest Control program; and

WHEREAS, the Water Wise Pest Control program, funded by a CalFed Grant to local stormwater agencies, was developed to reduce the amount of toxic pesticides entering local creeks and rivers through the storm drain system by providing less toxic and effective alternatives; and

WHEREAS, Mary Louise Flint was an integral part of the development of consumer-friendly Water Wise Pest Control program materials and has shared her expertise in Integrated Pest Management to help develop easy-to-understand public outreach materials; and

WHEREAS, Mary Louise Flint has been instrumental in developing a training program for local Master Gardeners on less toxic pest control methods; and

WHEREAS, Mary Louise Flint has helped to reach thousands of local residents with information on how toxic pesticides can enter our local waterways through the storm drain system and has provided information on how they can help protect water quality; and

WHEREAS, many residents throughout the state will also benefit from Sacramento's Water Wise program because of Mary Louise Flint's efforts, as the Water Wise program has distributed over 25,000 consumer cards and the program materials have been made available through 22 UC Extension offices statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Sacramento, that we do hereby recognize Mary Louise Flint for her outstanding efforts to protect the quality of our local creeks, lakes, and rivers and the quality of life for Sacramento residents.
