

# Resolution of Intention No. 2091

Pursuant to the authority of an Act of the Legislature of the State of California, known as the "Improvement Act of 1911," approved April 7th, 1911, and the several Acts amendatory thereof.

It is hereby resolved that it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Sacramento to order the following street work to be done, to-wit:

The improvement of the following in the City of Sacramento:

**40th Street, from the southerly line of 12th Avenue to the center line of 14th Avenue; by removing and disposing of all surplus and refuse material; constructing concrete curb and gutter and concrete sidewalk; placing cast iron gutter drains and connecting same to sewer system with vitrified ironstone sewer pipe; constructing vitrified ironstone pipe sewer; reconstructing existing manholes by placing curbs and covers to grade; placing street monuments; installing one (1) inch connections to City Water Main in accordance with Ordinance No. 14, 4th Series of the City of Sacramento; grading; and constructing an asphaltic concrete pavement with a seal coat.**

All of said work shall be done in accordance with the detailed plans therefor adopted by the said City Council and now on file in the office of the City Engineer, and also in accordance with the "Standard Specifications for the Improvement of Streets and Alleys and for the Construction of Sewers", heretofore adopted by said City Council.

Concrete curb and gutter shall conform to Cut No. 6 of said Specifications.

Seal Coat shall conform to provisions of Subdivision C of Section 22 of said Specifications.

Four (4) inch asphaltic concrete pavement shall be constructed as specified in Subdivisions A, B, C and D of Section 21 of said Specifications.

Cast iron gutter drains shall conform to Cut No. 7 of said Specifications.

Notice is hereby given that serial bonds to represent unpaid assessments and bear interest at the rate of seven (7) per cent per annum will be issued hereunder in the manner provided by the "Improvement Bond Act of 1915", the last installment of which bonds shall mature nine (9) years from the second day of July next succeeding ten (10) months from their date.

All persons objecting to said work, are required to file their objections in writing in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Sacramento, as required by law, and notice is hereby given to all persons interested that on the 17th day of June, 1926, at 8:15 o'clock P. M., in the Council Chamber of the City of Sacramento, in the City Hall on "I" Street, between 9th and 10 Streets, in said City any and all persons having any objections to the proposed work and improvement may appear before said City Council and show cause why the proposed work and improvement shall not be carried out in accordance with this Resolution.

And the City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Resolution twice in the Sacramento Union, a daily newspaper, as required by law.
