

MEAT INSPECTORS' PETITION

A petition received January 15, 1943, a copy of which was referred by the City Council to the Board for report, requested that Meat Inspectors'

salaries be increased to \$50.60 per week or \$219.26 per month. The Board reviewed the existing definition of a Meat Inspector and the usual occupations of each who had signed the petition. A letter from Geoffrey A. Boyd, Chief, Bureau of Meat Inspection, Department of Agriculture, State of California, dated January 22, 1943, stated that Meat Inspectors employed by the State received from \$140 to \$180 per month and Veterinary Meat Inspectors from \$200 to \$260 per month, and in addition to these salaries receive \$15.00 per month as an emergency salary increase. A letter from the Fresno Civil Service Board stated that Meat Inspectors receive \$180 to \$200 per month, although an eligible was recently appointed at \$150 per month. The Board also reviewed duties of Meat Cutters and Sausage Makers and after discussion concluded and agreed that duties of Meat Inspectors were not comparable to those of Meat Cutters and Sausage Makers. The Board also concluded and agreed that the usual occupations now being performed by the City of Sacramento Meat Inspectors fell within the definition of Meat Inspector. The Board also concluded and agreed that the duties of City Meat Inspectors fell within the duties outlined within the definition of Assistant Meat Inspectors as prepared by the Department of Agriculture, State of California. The Board also concluded and agreed that the State of California was the only jurisdiction in this locality having employees comparable to Meat Inspectors. After further discussion and agreement, it became the order of the Board that the above findings be reported to the City Council.

UNIFORM FIREMAN
ELIGIBLE REGISTER

A letter from Terence Mulligan, Chief of Fire Department, dated January 11, 1943, informed the Board that the Fire Department would continue to be in need of men during

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the duration. The Chief felt it might be necessary to raise the age limit required for Uniform Firemen, as men within Charter age limits might not be available. After discussion and agreement, it became the order of the Board that the Civil Service Board Office provide space on notices of temporary appointments for employees to sign a statement that he understand his employment was to be only of a temporary nature and that he had received said notice.

HARRY C. MAILEY
Patrolman List

A letter from Mr. Mailey dated January 28, 1943, stating that he was not certified from the Patrolman's List because he had been upon the "Inactive List" was received by the Board. He requested a decision as to whether or not his name would be placed at the top of the Patrolman's list after the present war or would it be placed in a position according to his percentage received in the examination. After review of the rules, the Board instructed the Secretary to advise Mr. Mailey that their interpretation of Rule IV Section 4 was that as long as his name had been reached in certification, it would be placed on the top of a new eligible register if requested by the candidate and honorable discharge was submitted within 90 days after release from military service. The Board requested that Mr. Mailey be so advised.

MARTIN JENNINGS

The Secretary reported that Mr. Jennings on January 26, 1943, requested information as to whether or not his final grade received during the last examination for Patrolman could be changed. After review of Mr. Jennings' application and information connected therewith, and upon agreement, it became the order of the Board that no change could be made.

MARY JOSEPH

Letter from Mary Joseph dated February 2, 1943, requesting information relating to her status as a Junior Clerk was con-

sidered by the Board. After discussion and agreement, it was the order of the Board that this matter be continued.

PATROLMAN ELIGIBLE LIST

A letter from A. K. McAllister, Chief of Police, requesting that an examination be held for Patrolman was considered by the Board. After discussion and agreement, it became the order of the Board that it was not practicable at this time because of charter age limit requirements and war conditions to hold an examination.

W. P. STEPHAN

The Board reviewed reports from the Fire Department and a letter received from Mr. Stephan September 12, 1942, a letter from Mr. E. C. Goldsworthy, Assistant Dean, University of California dated September 17, 1942, and a photostat copy of Mr. Stephan's appointment in the Naval Reserve dated June 2, 1942, also a letter received from Mr. Stephan dated November 27, 1942, all relating to Mr. Stephan's request for military leave of absence. After discussion and agreement, basing their agreement upon Mr. Stephen's statement in his letter received September 12, 1942, that his "present status is that of inactive reserve" it became the order of the Board that it was impossible for the Board to approve his leave as a military leave, that Mr. Stephan be so advised and that he ^{be} further advised that he should return to duty or supply information that he was in active military service.

FRANK KIERNAN

Pursant to the request of the Retirement Board, the Board reviewed information relating to Mr. Kiernan's date of birth. After reviewing a list of dates registered for voting and the age given by Mr. Kiernan at such time, and after reviewing certificate of baptism received from the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacramento, it became the order of the Board that Mr. Kiernan's birth was at latest during the year 1872, thus causing

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him to be more than 70 years of age at this time.

REX PRUDHOMME

A 90 day leave of absence without pay from December 21, 1942, to March 20, 1943, from the Water Department was considered by the Board. After determination that Mr. Prudhomme was a temporary appointee, the Secretary was instructed to inform the Water Department that said leave was disapproved and that in matters of this kind, appointees are laid off rather than being granted leaves.

A. J. BOLDEN

A 90 day leave of absence from the Fire Department, without pay, to become effective January 30, 1943, was considered by the Board. After review of Mr. Bolden's past history record and determination that he had been granted more than one 90 day leave of absence during the past year, the Secretary was instructed to inform the Fire Department regarding Rule VIII Section 1 wherein it would be impossible for the Board to approve this leave of absence for Mr. Bolden.

FRANK J. DEUTSCH

A letter from Mr. Deutsch received December 14, 1942, requesting an extension of his leave of absence which expired December 18, 1942, in order that Mr. Deutsch might continue as a Welder in a Richmond Ship Yard was received by the Board. After discussion and review of a memo. from City Manager Dean, as well as past policies of the Board, the Secretary was instructed to advise the Park Department and Mr. Deutsch that it was impossible to grant said leave.
