SUBJECT: Authorization to Amend the City Budget for
FY 1984-85 - Summer Youth Employment

SUMMARY

This report recommends amending the FY 1984-85 City budget to reflect funding to be received from the Sacramento Employment and Training Agency for the Summer Youth Employment Program in the amount of \$31,331.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On March 26, 1985, the City Council authorized, by resolution, the City Manager to submit a Summer Youth Employment Program Grant to the Sacramento Employment and Training Agency on behalf of the Department of Parks and Community Services, Recreation Division. The grant has been awarded in the amount of \$31,331. These funds will provide for the administration of the program. Ninety employment positions will be available to low income youth in various divisions of this department. Salaries for the youth will be paid directly by SETA.

FINANCIAL DATA

No additional City funds are required. All costs associated with this program are reimbursable from the awarding of the grant. The City provides in-kind services in the overall program administration and related services.

BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE ACTION

The Budget and Finance Committee will review this item at their meeting on April 16, 1985. Committee action will be presented verbally to the Council.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council, by resolution, authorize amending the City budget for FY 1984-85 as follows:
