SUBJECT: California Waste Management Board Approval of the
City's Local Enforcement Agency Designation

SUMMARY

On March 7, 1985 the California Waste Management Board (CWMB) approved Sacramento City's designation of the County Health Department as its sole Local Enforcement Agency for solid waste. The CWMB also approved the County Health Department's Solid Waste Enforcement Program.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On January 10, 1985 the California Waste Management Board (CWMB) requested the City of Sacramento to take those actions necessary to designate a single solid waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA). On January 23, 1985 the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors resolved to designate its Health Department as our sole LEA upon concurrence of the Sacramento City Council. On February 8, 1985 the City Council also resolved to designate the County Health Department as its sole LEA upon approval of the CWMB. At its March 8, 1985 meeting the CWMB unanimously approved the City's LEA designation.

At the same time as the aforementioned LEA designation approval, the CWMB approved a County Health Department "Solid Waste Enforcement Program" that requires solid waste facility operators to respond with a letter of compliance to violations of a serious nature.

The Health Department's request for a letter of compliance response to landfill violations fulfills Councilman Pope's inquiry as to what follow-up action is required when landfill violations occur.

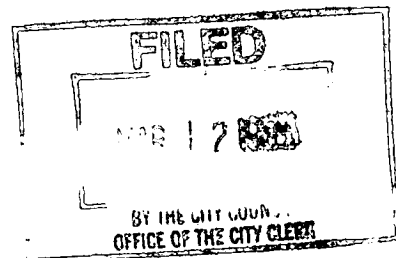
