**SUBJECT: Various Action Related to the City Sponsored School-age Child
Care Program**

SUMMARY

This report requests action related to The 4th "R" school-age child care program sponsored by the City of Sacramento. It is recommended that the annual renewal application for FY 1989-90 State Department of Education contract number CD-5176 be approved.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Recreation Division operates a school-age child care program called The 4th "R." The program is supported by participant fees and State Department of Education operating grant funds. The program currently serves approximately sixty youngsters who are subsidized by the state grant and over seven hundred children full paying. The program operates at fifteen elementary school sites in the Sacramento City Unified School District.

The subsidized program with the state requires the annual renewal or resubmission of the grant application. While not anticipating any additional funding for low-income children, the program will be expanding to seven or more sites next school year to accommodate continuing interest among full paying participants. The new sites are currently being determined in cooperation with the Sacramento City Unified School District.

FINANCIAL DATA

No City funds are required to approve the contract for FY 1989-90. All costs associated with The 4th "R" are reimbursed from the operating grant or recovered from participant fees.


