

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 2384

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, the public interest and convenience require that the work and improvement hereinafter described should be done;

NOW, THEREFORE, the said City Council of the City of Sacramento does hereby resolve and declare that it is the intention of said City Council to order the following work and improvement to be done in said City, to-wit:

To close, vacate and abandon the following described alley:

The alley between "J" and "K" Streets, from the westerly line of 20th Street, to a point 80 feet westerly therefrom.

And said City Council does hereby determine and declare that the exterior boundaries of the district of lands which will be affected or benefited by said work and improvement are described as follows, viz:

On the north by "J" Street; on the south by "K" Street; on the east by 20th Street; and on the west by a line parallel to 20th Street and 80 feet westerly therefrom, measured at right angles.

And the City Council does further determine and declare that said abandonment is to be made upon the express condition that in the event that the portion of the said alley lying west of the Western Pacific Railroad Company's tracks is physically opened and put to use as a public alley, the abandonment proposed in this resolution shall become and stand annulled and cancelled at the option of the City of Sacramento.

The entire damages, costs and expenses of said work and improvement shall be, and are hereby, made chargeable against, and shall be assessed upon, the land in the district described as aforesaid. All of the said work and improvement shall be done in accordance with the provisions of the act of the legislature of the State of California entitled "An Act to Provide for the Laying out, Opening, Extending, Widening, Straightening or Closing up in whole or in part any Street, Square, Lane, Alley, Court or Place Within Municipalities and to Condemn and Acquire any and all land and Property necessary or convenient for that purpose," approved March 6, 1889, and the several acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto.

The Street Superintendent is hereby directed to cause notices of the passage of this resolution to be printed and posted in accordance with law, and to cause a notice similar in substance to be published in the "Sacramento Union," a daily newspaper published and circulated in the said City of Sacramento, all as prescribed by law.




