## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF PROPERTIES FOR 5TH AVENUE WIDENING

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary in connection with the Widening of 5th Avenue, between Sacramento Boulevard and Stockton Boulevard, to purchase from the following owners those certain real properties described as follows:

N. 12 feet, more or less, of Lot 28 "Buena Vista"  
together with residence on rear of said lot  
Consideration \$2100.00

W. B. Phillips, et al  
S. 40' Lots 15 and 16 "Sunset Addition"  
Consideration, \$1900.00

Joseph R. Petrovich  
Fractional northwest corner Lot 24 "Reese Villa"  
Consideration, \$75.00  
This property is being purchased on account of  
the re-alignment of the intersection of 42nd and  
"D" Streets

CITY OF SACRAMENTO:


That the City of Sacramento purchase said properties from
