

RESOLUTION No. 203

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

August 8th, 1929.

RESOLUTION FIXING THE CHARGES FOR THE USE OF THE SACRAMENTO MUNICIPAL AUDITORIUM, AND PROVIDING FOR ITS OPERATION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

The following rates for the use of the Sacramento Municipal Auditorium are hereby established:

1. Conventions:

(a) For conventions where no admission is charged and no financial profit derived, there shall be no rental charge; but applicants must pay for all janitor service, lights and extras.

(b) For Conventions where admission is charged, including committee rooms, main Auditorium with stage:

Day.....	\$125.00
Night.....	150.00
Day and Night.....	175.00

Main Auditorium without stage:

Day.....	\$100.00
Night.....	125.00
Day and Night.....	150.00

(c) Where there are exhibits or concessions for profit, shall be an extra charge, on a schedule formulated by the Superintendent and approved by the City Manager.

2. Fraternal organizations, ceremonials, initiations, or receptions, where floor is to be used for dances, no admission charge, with stage:

Day.....	\$ 75.00
Night.....	100.00
Day and Night.....	125.00

Note: If any dances run past 1:00 a. M., an additional charge of \$15.00 per hour.

Where admission is charged and open to the public:

Day.....	\$100.00
Night.....	150.00
Day and Night.....	175.00

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2. Cont'd.

Note: An additional charge of \$15.00 per Hour, if dance runs past 1:00 a. M.

3. Fraternal, religious or other organizations, for lectures or other meetings, open to the public, where no admission is charged, main Auditorium with stage:

Day.....	\$ 50.00
Night.....	62.50
Day and night.....	75.00

4. Local productions of choral and orchestral works, opera, oratorio, drama, pageants by schools or other amateur groups, where admission is charged:

Day.....	\$ 50.00
Night.....	75.00
Day and Night.....	100.00

5. Professional theatricals, concerts, operatic attractions and motion pictures, where admission is charged, auditorium and stage, one performance, day or night:

Admission not over 50¢.....	\$150.00
Over 50¢ and not over \$1.00.....	200.00
Over \$1.00 & not over \$2.00.....	250.00
Over \$2.00.....	300.00

Auditorium and stage, day and night, two performances, where admission is charged:

Not over 50¢.....	\$250.00
Over 50¢ and not over \$1.00.....	300.00
Over \$1.00 and not over \$2.00.....	350.00
Over \$2.00.....	400.00

6. Established local musical and literary clubs for professional concerts, for recitals or lectures, where admission is charged; auditorium and stage:

Day.....	\$ 75.00
Night.....	100.00
Day and Night.....	150.00

7. City Recreation Department and public school functions where admission is charged; lectures, etc., Auditorium and stage:

Day.....	50.00
Night.....	75.00
Day and Night.....	100.00

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7. Cont'd.

Where no admission is charged or financial profit to be derived:

Day.....	\$ 50.00
Night.....	62.50
Day and Night.....	75.00

8. Automobile shows, food shows, fashion shows, carnivals, fairs,

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Animal Shows:

Day.....	175.00
Night.....	225.00
Day and Night.....	250.00

If basement floor is used in connection with show, \$50.00 additional.

No machinery or heavy equipment permitted on main floor.

9. Boxing, public dances, wrestling or athletic exhibitions:

Day or night	
Main Audt'm without stage or committee rooms.....	125.00
Main Audt'm with stage or Committee rooms.....	150.00
Main Audt'm with stage and with Committee rooms.....	175.00

Note: An additional charge of \$15.00 per hour if entertainment or dance runs past 1:00 a.m.

Provided however, that one-half of the foregoing prices shall be paid in case of use sponsored by and held under the auspices of local patriotic bodies for the benefit of ex-service men or women, or for auxiliary organizations.

10. Little Theatre:

Day.....	\$ 15.00
Night.....	20.00
Day and night.....	25.00

11. Memorial Hall:

Day.....	\$ 5.50
Night.....	12.50
Day and Night.....	15.00

12. In lieu of above rates the Superintendent may arrange with the lessees for compensation on a percentage basis, subject to the approval of the City Manager.

13. For any use not above specified a charge may be fixed by the Superintendent, subject to the approval of the City Manager.

14. Reservation must be assured by deposit of 10% of rental price on date of reservation; and Superintendent is authorized to require balance

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balance to be paid in advance on the day of performance before doors are opened. When rental is on a percentage basis, the Superintendent shall estimate the advance rental to be required.

15. For use of any units of the auditorium over an extended period of time a special rate may be fixed by the Superintendent, to be approved by the City Council; but no lease shall be made which would tend to give a monopoly of any unit to any organization or individual, or tend to prevent the general use of any of the units of the auditorium.

16. For the use of the Main Auditorium with Stage and Committee Room for New Year's Eve, a minimum of \$400.00 shall be charged, provided that the City Council in its discretion may let the use thereof for New Year's Eve to the highest competitive bidder; provided that the City is not using the auditorium for that evening. (Note: Additional charge of \$25.00 per hour if the use runs past 1:00 A. M.)

17. The Superintendent shall have the authority with the sanction of the City Manager to refuse the use of the Auditorium or any part thereof to any lessee where such use would be contrary to sound public policy.


18. That the use of the Memorial Hall shall be free of cost to patriotic organizations for regular meetings, which uses shall be arranged so that same shall not interfere with paid rentals, on a schedule of dates to be arranged by the Superintendent.
