

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE GOVERNING BOARD
OF
SACRAMENTO COMMUNITY CENTER AUTHORITY
April 27, 1970

A meeting of the Governing Board of Sacramento Community Center Authority was held at the City Hall, Sacramento, California, on April 27, 1970, at the hour of 4:30 o'clock p. m., of said day, pursuant to notice received by all members of the Governing Board, fixing the time and place of meeting.

Directors present: George W. Artz, Vincent M. Caselli, Walter Christensen, David C. Rust, Ed Combatalade and Alfred W. Riolo, Alternates.

Directors absent: Tony Westra.

Chairman Christensen called the meeting to order at 4:30 o'clock p. m.

Upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, the minutes of the meeting of April 20, 1970, were approved.

Alternate Director Riolo suggested that an attempt be made to build the Center with private capital to be obtained from gifts, raffles and fund drives, etc.

Chairman Christensen noting the difficulty of raising funds by donations, stated that the original thought was for the embellishments to be obtained by private donations.

Director Artz suggested that the Authority Counsel consult with the Bond Counsel to see if there would be any objections to raising money in the manner suggested by Alternate Director Riolo.

Director Rust, referring to the central location of the downtown center with relation to the Sacramento area freeway system, suggested that aerial survey maps be obtained from the State Department of Public Works for use in an educational campaign.

A general discussion was then had and it was generally agreed that a need existed for a promotional program to arouse community support and interest in the Community Center.

The Board meeting was recessed at 5:02 o'clock p. m. to meet in executive session and reconvened at 5:43 o'clock p. m.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, the meeting was adjourned at the hour of 5:45 o'clock p. m.
