A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF CALTRANS ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE GRANT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$237,960; AND AUTHORIZING A CONSULTANT SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH PARSONS BRINCKERHOFF QUADE & DOUGLAS, INC. FOR URBAN DESIGN PLANS, STREETScape PLANS, INFRASTRUCTURE PLANS, AND CIRCULATION PLANS FOR THE FLORIN ROAD AND MEADOWVIEW ROAD LIGHT RAIL TRANSIT (LRT) STATIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$339,943 (M03-188, M03-013)

WHEREAS, the State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), Division of Transportation Planning (DOTP) provides grants to promote Environmental Justice: Context-Sensitive Planning for Communities and;

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento applied and was awarded a grant of \$237,960 through the Environmental Justice Grant Program to provide for analysis and outreach as part of a Community Plan Update process, in particular to better reach under-represented segments of the community in providing for future land use and transportation policy and improvements and in implementing recommendations for transit-oriented development and;

WHEREAS, the Airport-Meadowview / South Sacramento Community Plan Update currently underway will benefit from the enhanced community outreach and Environmental Justice Policy creation made possible by the use of the Environmental Justice Grant funds secured and;

WHEREAS, the Infrastructure Needs Assessments, Urban Design Plans, and Traffic Analysis for the Light Rail Transit Station Areas at Meadowview Road and Florin Road will be enhanced with illustrative schematic development plans through the application of the Environmental Justice Grant funds as proposed and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Sacramento hereby:

1. Accepts a Grant Award of \$237,960 from the Environmental Justice Grant Program; and
2. Authorizes the execution of a Consultant Services Agreement with Parsons Brinckerhoff Quade and Douglas, Inc. in the amount of \$339,943 for Urban Design Plans, Streetscape Plans, Infrastructure Plans, and Circulation Plans for the Florin Road and Meadowview Road Light Rail Transit (LRT) Stations; and
3. Appoints Gary Stonehouse, City Planning Director, as agent of the City of Sacramento to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to applications, agreement, amendments, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned projects, as outlined in existing city policy.
