RATIFYING AND AUTHORIZING CHANGE ORDER #1: FORT NATOMAS AT SOUTH NATOMS COMMUNITY PARK (L19156200)

BACKGROUND

- A. The City Council on August 19, 2008 adopted Resolution 2008-586, which suspended competitive bidding in the best interests of the City for all contracts and agreements related to the design and construction of the Fort Natomas at South Natomas Community Park and authorized the City Manager to execute construction contracts in an amount not to exceed \$750,000 per single contract.
- B. On September 12, 2008, the City Manager executed Contract #2008-220 with Biundo Landscape Construction in an amount not to exceed \$449,234.
- C. On November 21, 2008, the City Manager executed Change Order #1 to Contract #2008-220 with Biundo Landscape Construction in the amount of \$76,259.50 consistent with City Code Section 3.60.210(D) in order to prevent interruption of the work which would result in a substantial increase in cost to the city.
- D. There are sufficient funds in the Fort Natomas at South Natomas Community Park Project, L19156200 for the City Manager to execute Change Order #1.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Change Order #1 to Contract #2008-220 with Biundo Landscape Construction in the amount of \$76,259.50 is ratified and authorized.


