

RESOLUTION NO. 2008-198

AUTHORIZATION TO APPLY FOR GRANT FUNDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF A FIRE STATION ALERTING SYSTEM

BACKGROUND

- A. The essential component within each fire station for receiving dispatch alerts and incident information is the Fire Station Alerting System.
- B. The current fire alerting system, installed over fifteen years ago, was designed using custom-built, proprietary components which have become unreliable, obsolete and are deteriorating.
- C. The Fire Department is seeking grant funding to replace the current system with a commercially available and supportable system to provide a more reliable and functional notification system.
- D. On March 3, 2008, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security opened the application period for the *Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program*. Applications are due by April 4, 2008.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to apply for grant funding for the purchase of a Fire Station Alerting System.
