**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE MASTER PLAN, MITIGATED NEGATIVE  
DECLARATION, MITIGATION REPORTING PLAN AND FINANCIAL ACTIONS FOR THE  
DEVELOPMENT OF PHASE II OF GRANITE REGIONAL PARK**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sacramento has conducted an Initial Study to determine if the Project may have a significant effect on the environment; and

**WHEREAS**, the Initial Study concluded that there is no substantial evidence that the Project, or any of its aspects, may cause a significant effect on the environment and, therefore, a Negative Declaration is appropriate; and

**WHEREAS**, A Mitigation Reporting Plan has been prepared which is designed to ensure compliance with the mitigation measures incorporated into the Project Negative Declaration; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sacramento has circulated the Negative Declaration for public review in accordance with CEQA.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has supported the financing the development of an all-weather lighted soccer field and a regional skatepark at Granite Regional Park.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has supported the preparation of \$1,650,000 in competitive grant proposals for the development of an all-weather lighted soccer field and a regional skatepark at Granite Regional Park.

**The City Council hereby:**

1. Approves the Master Plan for Granite Regional Park Phase II,
2. Approves the Mitigated Negative Declaration and Mitigation Reporting Plan for Granite Regional Park Phase II,
3. Establishes a Capital Improvement Project for Granite Regional Park Phase II CIP (PN: LV93),

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4. Transfers \$568,518 (Fund 512) from the Youth Recreation Improvement Fund CIP (PN: KC41) to Granite Regional Park Phase II CIP (PN: LV93),
5. Transfers \$327,651 (Fund 101) from the Youth Recreation Improvement Fund CIP (PN: KC41) to Granite Regional Park Phase II CIP (PN: LV93),
6. Transfers \$1,000,000 (Fund 512) from the Proposition 40 RZH Block Grant Fund CIP (PN: LZ86) to Granite Regional Park Phase II CIP (PN: LV93),
7. Transfers \$700,000 (Fund 512) from the Proposition 40 Per Capita Grant Fund CIP (PN: LZ66) to the Youth Recreation Improvement Fund CIP (PN: KC41), and
8. Approves returning any fund balance in the Granite Regional Park Phase II CIP (PN: LV93) to the Youth Recreation Improvement Fund CIP (PN: KC41), if competitive grant funding is secured.
