SUBJECT: COMSULTANT SELECTION PROCEDURES FOR THE 1400 J STREET OFFICE BUILDING

SUMMARY

The City Planning Division has recently received an application for a major office building at 1400 J Street. As proposed the project will consist of 500,000 square feet of office use, 16,000 square feet of retail space, and parking for 800 vehicles in a single building of 26 stories. The developed project site is located on the southeast corner of 14th and J Streets in the Central City. The site is currently zoned Central Business District (C-3) and is designated Regional Commercial and Office in the 1986-2006 General Plan. The proposal is a project pursuant to CEQA and will require the preparation of an EIR.

The City Planning Division proposes that a selection committee, consisting of a City Planning Commissioner, a Public Works staff person, and two members of Planning's Environmental Section, select a consultant to prepare the EIR. Staff believes that the proposed composition of the committee will provide a variety of knowledge and experience to select a qualified and capable consultant.
