A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA, CALLING AND GIVING NOTICE OF THE SUBMISSION TO THE VOTERS OF A QUESTION(S) RELATING TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING AS REQUIRED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA RELATING TO CHARTER CITIES

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the laws relating to Charter Cities in the State of California, a General Municipal Election shall be held on November 2, 2004, for the purpose of submitting a question(s) to the voters pertaining to the number of affordable housing dwelling units to be developed, constructed, or acquired over the next 10 to 20 years; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

Section 1: That the City Council, pursuant to its right and authority, does order submitted to the voters at the consolidated General Municipal Election the following question:

"Do the qualified electors of the City of Sacramento approve the development, construction, or acquisition of affordable housing within the City for households such as seniors, working families, and the disabled, referred in statute as low rent housing, not to exceed 3,000 dwelling units over the next 10 to 20 years?" Section 2: That the proposed complete text of the measure submitted to the voters is as specifically stated in the ballot question under Section 1 of this resolution.

Section 3: That the ballots to be used at the election shall be in form and content as required by law.

Section 4: That the City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to procure and furnish any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election.

Section 5: That the polls for the election shall be open at 7:00 a.m. of the day of the election and shall remain open continuously from that time until 8:00 p.m. of the same day when the polls shall be closed, except as provided in Section 14301 of the Elections Code of the State of California.


Section 6: That in all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

Section 7: That notice of the time and place of holding the election is given and the City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to give further or additional notice of the election, in time, form and manner as required by law.

Section 8: That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
