

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-0198

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

May 28, 2019

Establishment of a Multi-Year Operating Project and Transfer of Funds

BACKGROUND

- A. On November 13, 2018, City Council passed Resolution 2018-0438 declaring remaining district funds from Midtown Street Lighting Assessment District No. 2003-05 (Midtown AD) and Tahoe Park West Street Lighting Assessment District No. 2003-06 (Tahoe Park West AD) in the amount of \$57,000 as surplus and ordering the disposition of the surplus funds to the City's General Fund.
- B. Council directed the surplus funds related to the Midtown AD to the Midtown Streetlighting Project that is currently underway and for City staff to work with District 6 on using the surplus related to Tahoe Park AD to fund an appropriate project in that district.
- C. City Treasurer's Office staff worked with Council and Public Works Department staff to identify the McKinley Park Street Lighting Project ("McKinley Project") as the project that could be funded in part from the surplus related to the Midtown AD. The McKinley Project (T15185102) is one of the priorities of the McKinley Village Alt Trans Imp Project (T15185100) which encompasses the installation of new streetlights in an area bounded by 27th Street, C Street, 29th Street, and E Street.
- D. City Treasurer's Office staff worked with District 6 to identify the Habitat for Humanity ("Habitat Project") as the project to fund with the surplus related to the Tahoe Park West AD.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The Habitat Project (I01000600) is established.
- Section 2. The City Manager or the City Manger's designee is authorized to establish an expenditure budget in I01000600 by transferring \$30,000 from the General Fund (Fund 1001) available fund balance.

Section 3. The City Manager or the City Manger's designee is authorized to appropriate \$27,000 in the McKinley Village Alt Trans Imp Project (T15185100) by transferring from the General Fund (Fund 1001) available fund balance.
