OFFICIAL CANVASS OF RETURNS
AND
DECLARATION OF RESULT OF VOTES CAST

REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION
NOVEMBER 8, 1949

WHEREAS, pursuant to provisions of the City Charter and Resolutions heretofore adopted, the City Council has met as a Canvassing Board to canvass the returns of Regular Municipal Election held in City of Sacramento on Tuesday, November 8, 1949:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Sacramento hereby declares the Result of the Votes Cast at Regular Municipal Election held in said City on date of November 8, 1949, as follows:

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following named nine (9) Candidates having received the highest number of votes cast for said offices of the City Council be and the same are hereby declared duly elected as members of the City Council of the City of Sacramento for the term of two (2) years from date of January 1st, 1950, viz, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that James M. McDonnell having been the only nominee, be and he is hereby declared to have been duly elected as Judge of Office No. 1 of the Municipal Court of the City of Sacramento for a term of six (6) years, beginning January 1st, 1950; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk be and he is hereby authorized to issue certificates of Election to the successful candidates herein named; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Proposal A for amendment of Section 86 of the City Charter providing that the Annual Tax Levy shall be fixed by ordinance not later than first Monday in September having received a majority of the votes cast for said proposal is hereby declared to have been duly ratified, confirmed and adopted by the people of the City of Sacramento at said Election; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Proposal B to add Section 17a providing for the regulation and punishment of persons wilfully violating Civil Service Regulation; to amend Section 41 authorizing payment of meetings to members of the Civil Service Board; to amend Section 42 providing for the appointment of a personnel officer; to add Section 48a authorizing the Civil Service Board to certify payrolls to the Controller; to amend Section 165 requiring every officer or employee to have three consecutive years residence within the city, these sections to be added to the City Charter, not having received the majority of all of the votes cast for said proposal is hereby declared to have been defeated and rejected by the people of the City of Sacramento at said Election; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Proposal C for the amendment of Sections 15 and 251 providing that four consecutive days notice by publication be given, when advertising for bids, to be added to the City Charter, having received a majority of the votes cast for said proposal is hereby declared to have been duly ratified, confirmed and adopted by the people of the City of Sacramento at said Election; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Proposal D to amend Subdivision (d) of Section 173 of the City Charter, providing that should an employee die after rendering 20 years continuous service, his widow shall be entitled to a pension allowance equal to two-thirds of his pension, having received a majority of the votes cast for said proposal is hereby declared to have been duly ratified, confirmed and adopted by the people of the City of Sacramento at said Election; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Proposal E to amend Section 261 of the City Charter, providing for the receipt of bids for official advertising by any daily newspaper having a bona-fide list of at least 500 paid subscriptions, not having received the majority of all of the votes cast for said proposal is hereby declared to have been defeated and rejected by the people of the City of Sacramento at said Election; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk of the City of Sacramento be and he is hereby directed to prepare a certification of foregoing action by the people of said City on foregoing amendments, transmitting same to the City Attorney, who is hereby ordered and directed to have said amendments submitted to and ratified by the Legislature of the State of California through Sacramento's Legislative Representatives.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the consolidated tabulation sheet prepared by the City Clerk, showing the number of votes cast in all precincts for each candidate and the number of votes for and against each Charter Amendment Proposal submitted at each Election is hereby made a part of this resolution and attached to the original thereof on file in office of the City Clerk; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT with the adoption of this resolution, the City Council hereby declares its duty as a canvassing board to have been completed and thereupon adjourns.
