AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA FIRE AND RESCUE TRAINING AUTHORITY (CFRTA) FOR \$100,000

BACKGROUND

- A. Through a cooperative agreement with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), the City of Sacramento as the Sponsoring Agency has agreed to provide direction and management of all Urban Search & Rescue (US&R) California Task Force Seven (CA TF-7) activities.
- B. Under the terms and conditions of the current cooperative agreement between FEMA and the Sacramento Fire Department, the Fire Department has agreed to execute one Task Force mobilization exercise annually.
- C. The California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (CA, OES), as a member agency of CFRTA, has allocated specific funding to CFRTA for the purposes of conducting these mobilization exercises.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute the agreement between the Fire Department and the California Fire & Rescue Training Authority.

Section 2. The Fiscal Year 2006/07 Fire Department budget is augmented as follows:
