SUMMARY

The Solid Waste Division ordered and received 2,500 each automated lift 90-gallon wheeled refuse containers under Bid No. 749. This shipment represents an amount less than required to completely automate the route projected to receive the containers. The contractor, Heil Equipment Co., has agreed to honor the offered price of \$68.65 (including tax) each if we place an order for an additional 2,500 units. It is recommended that the City Council suspend formal competitive bidding for the purchase of this requirement.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Formal Bid No. 749 for this type of container was solicited on November 20, 1984 and award was made to Heil Equipment Co. on January 3, 1985 with a final shipment to be no later than April 26, 1985. The next lowest price was \$80.91, including tax. It is determined to be in the best interest of the City to again purchase these containers from Heil Equipment Co.

FINANCIAL DATA

The total cost of this purchase is \$171,587.50. The contractor has agreed to start production now and withhold demand for payment until the Solid Waste Division's 85/86 fiscal year budget is approved in July.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that pursuant to Section 57.401(c) of the Sacramento City Code, the City Council adopt a resolution suspending formal competitive bidding for the purchase of 2,500 automated lift 90-gallon wheeled refuse containers and authorize the City Manager to execute the necessary contract with Heil Equipment Company, 8540 Thys Court, Sacramento, CA 95828, in the total amount of \$171,587.50.
