**RESOLUTION OVERRULING PROTESTS
FRANKLIN BOULEVARD PROPERTY AND
BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FY 2005/06**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. On June 7, 2005, City Council opened a public hearing on the resolution of intention to levy and collect assessments in the Franklin Boulevard Property and Business Improvement District and continued the public hearing on June 21, 2005 and extended the continuance of the public hearing on June 28, 2005.
2. At or before the time set for hearing, certain interested persons made protests or objections to the proposed services, the extent of the assessment district or the proposed assessment.
3. City Council hereby overrules each of these protests, written or oral.
4. City Council finds that the protest against the proposed services (including all written protests not withdrawn in writing before the conclusion of the protest hearing) is made by the owners of property who will pay less than 50% of the total assessments proposed.
