AND
THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO REGARDING
THE DEVELOPMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND LAND USE MEASURES
FOR THE SACRAMENTO AIR QUALITY PLAN

THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING between Sacramento Regional Area Planning Commission (SRAPC) and the City of Sacramento, entered into September 2, 1980, is hereby amended to add the following:

"Section 10) ASSIGNMENTS:

The Sacramento Regional Area Planning Commission is an area planning commission established pursuant to Article 11, Chapter 5, Title 7 of the Government Code.

On October 21, 1980, the member cities and counties of SRAPC entered into a Joint Powers Agreement establishing the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG), effective on January 15, 1981.

SRAPC is hereby empowered to transfer and assign its obligations and rights under this Memorandum of Understanding to SACOG as of January 15, 1981. As of that date, SACOG shall be the Commission's successor in interest for all purposes relating to this Memorandum of Understanding. All references to SRAPC in this Memorandum of Understanding shall be deemed to be the Sacramento Area Council of Governments."

This Amendment shall become effective on January 15, 1981.
