

RESOLUTION No. 157

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

March 28 1929

WHEREAS, the Federal Government has advertised for bids for a site of a new postoffice and Federal Building in Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento owns the West 105 feet of the North half of the block between 10th and 11th, I and J Streets, and Sacramento School District owns the 135 feet of said one-half block adjoining to the East; and


WHEREAS, it appears to the Council that this site would be an excellent one, facing as it does on the City Plaza and thus tending to make in Sacramento a Civic Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is the sense of this Council that said City Property be offered to the Federal Government for a site, provided that the Sacramento School Board also offers its property for same purpose; that the price to said Government be fixed at the sum of \$161,000.00, same being the cost of said property to said City of Sacramento
