

RESOLUTION NO. 2005-557

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

APPROVING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, ACCEPTING LOW BID AND AWARDING CONTRACT FOR J STREET RUBBERIZED ASPHALT OVERLAY PROJECT ALHAMBRA BOULEVARD TO CARLSON DRIVE (PN: RMGI)

BACKGROUND

- A. The overlay program is an annual preventative maintenance project. Investing in overlays prevent more costly road reconstruction in the future

A Rubberized Asphalt Concrete (RAC) overlay for J Street is recommended for the following reasons:

1. Cost effectiveness. Using RAC will enable the City to achieve 10 year design life at less cost than with a conventional overlay.
2. Noise reduction. It is anticipated that noise levels will be reduced by 3 – 4 decibels, which is a perceptible decrease to the human ear.
3. Environmentally friendly. Approximately 19,000 tires will be used on J Street that would otherwise go to landfill.

- B. This project was advertised and bids were received on June 29, 2005 and are summarized below.

Contractor	Bid Amount (Base Alternate)	ESBD Participation (20% goal)
Martin Brothers	1,093,069	87.7%
Granite Construction Company, Inc.	1,283,405	20.5%
Teichert Construction Company	1,395,819	22%

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$1,080,488.

The Award to Martin Brothers Construction is the lowest responsive and responsible bid.


- C. Construction is expected to begin in August 2005 and be completed in October 2005.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Plans and specifications for the J Street Rubberized Asphalt Overlay Project (PN: RM61) are approved.
- Section 2. The low bid of Martin Brothers Construction in the amount of \$1,093,069 is accepted.
- Section 3. The City Manager is authorized and directed to execute a contract in the amount of \$1,093,069 with Martin Brothers Construction.
