

RESOLUTION No. 229

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

September 19th, 1929

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of September, 1929, the City Council having awarded to the Western Pacific Railroad Company the renewal of a wharf franchise in accordance with provisions of Ordinance No. 438, Fourth Series; and


WHEREAS, the Western Pacific Railroad Company, pursuant to provisions of the City Charter of the City of Sacramento, has within ten (10) days after the passage of the said Ordinance granting said franchise, duly executed, and filed with this Council a bond in the penal sum of One thousand (\$1000) Dollars bearing date of the 17th day of September, 1929, and conditioned as prescribed by the provisions of said Charter; and

WHEREAS, upon due investigation and consideration, it appears to the satisfaction of this Council that said bond is in proper form and that said bond has been duly executed by said Western Pacific Railroad Company and by good and sufficient sureties;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that said bond be and it is hereby accepted and approved.
