NEIGHBORHOOD HIRING POLICY ON PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1. A neighborhood hiring policy demonstration program for public works projects shall be conducted by the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency.

Section 2. The Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency shall monitor and evaluate the demonstration program and shall prepare and submit a report in six months with the results and a recommended overall local hiring policy.

Section 3. Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Tax Increment funded public works projects to be included in the demonstration program are Del Paso Heights 6B and Oak Park Commercial Street Improvements


Section 4: The bids for such public works projects shall be reviewed by a panel of which there will be at least one City Council Member and one Commissioner of the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Commission.

Section 5: The construction agreements for such public works projects shall state that "failure by the contractor to comply with the neighborhood hiring policy shall be a default under the terms of the agreement."
