SUBJECT: LIBRARY SCHEDULES

SUMMARY

This report discusses a shift in library open hours to more closely match times the public has indicated libraries should be open. The change is recommended to take effect January 3, 1983.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

In developing the Master Plan, it was determined that one of the major library issues for library users and non-users is library service schedules.

The attached schedule more closely matches citizen's needs and is within the capabilities of the Library Department. This schedule is intended to be in effect through June 30, 1983. Beginning July 1, 1983, it is anticipated that funds provided by recently passed state legislation will allow for an overall increase in total open hours.

There are four significant advantages to the changes outlined on the attached schedule:

1. King Library, a major resource, will be open Mondays, including Monday night. King is now closed on Mondays.
2. Two libraries (King and McClatchy) will provide library service within City limits on Monday evening, whereas no service is currently provided Monday nights.
3. Opening and closing times for libraries are more uniform -- particularly Friday and Saturday, making it easier for the public to know when they can expect library service.
4. Friday morning closures of all libraries except Central will provide an efficient opportunity for training and administrative activities. This will improve the overall quality of library service during open hours.

The overall change in library open hours is a net reduction of 26 resulting from Friday morning closures. Total weekly service hours will be 409.

County Library facilities will change hours to be consistent with City branch operations.

FINANCIAL DATA

Opening Martin Luther King, Jr. Library on Mondays will cost approximately \$4,000 for January through June, 1983.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the proposed library schedules to be effective January 3, 1983 through June 30, 1983.


