SUBJECT: Approval of Plans and Specifications for Center Parkway

Median Landscaping - Valley Hi Drive to Calvine Road

SUMMARY:

Plans and specifications for the subject project have been prepared and approval is recommended.

FINANCIAL:

In the F.Y. 1977/78 Capital Improvement Program, the City Council approved the appropriation of \$90,000 from Gas Tax funds for the Landscaping Improvements to the Center Parkway Median from Valley Hi Drive to Calvine Road. The project is estimated to cost approximately \$125,825. There is approximately \$85,000 remaining in unencumbered funds for the project, leaving a deficiency of approximately \$41,000. It is proposed that the needed additional funds be appropriated from the Major Street Construction Tax fund. Although the estimate exceeds the amount budgeted and funds will need to be appropriated, it is believed that bids should be received and analyzed before a final budgetary recommendation is made to the City Council.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Budget and Finance Committee recommend to the full City Council that the plans and specifications be approved and that this project be advertised for bids.
