SUBJECT: Suspension of Formal Competitive Bidding for the Repair of
One (1) Each D-8 "Caterpillar" Tractor

SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Equipment Maintenance Division has a requirement for the repair of one (1) each D-8 "Caterpillar" tractor. Since the parts required for this repair are only available from a "Caterpillar" dealer and Tenco Sacramento is the only authorized service/dealer in the greater Sacramento area, it is recommended that this repair be done by Tenco Sacramento. The replacement cost for this tractor is approximately \$200,000 and the estimated repair cost is \$25,990; therefore, it is recommended that the City Council suspend formal competitive bidding for this requirement.

FINANCIAL DATA

The estimated cost for this repair is \$25,990 (\$17,490 for parts and \$8,500 for labor). Sufficient funds are available in this division's current 1979/80 fiscal year budget.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council adopt a resolution suspending formal competitive bidding for the repair of one (1) each D-8 "Caterpillar" tractor and authorizing the City Manager to execute the necessary contract with Tenco Sacramento in the estimated amount of \$25,990.
