

RESOLUTION NO. 553

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council
on date of
February 3, 1939

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of
Sacramento:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of
Sacramento proposes to submit on its own motion and does hereby
submit to the qualified electors of the City of Sacramento the
following proposal to amend Section 73 of the Charter of the
City of Sacramento, as follows, to wit:

PROPOSAL NO. 1

To amend Section 73 of the Charter of the
City of Sacramento as follows:

"FISCAL YEAR

Sec. 73. The City Council is hereby
authorized to fix and determine the fiscal
year of the City and to change the same from
time to time as need may arise."

Section 2. For the purpose of submitting the foregoing
proposal to the qualified electors of the City of Sacramento,
a special election is hereby called to be held in said City on
Tuesday, March 28, 1939.

Section 3. The City Clerk of the City of Sacramento
is hereby ordered and directed to cause said proposed amendment
to the Charter of the City of Sacramento to be published once
in The Sacramento Union,
the official newspaper of said City, and in each edition thereof
during the day of publication, said newspaper being a newspaper
of general circulation published in said City; and such publica-
tion may be in substantially the following form, to wit:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

to

THE CHARTER

of the

CITY OF SACRAMENTO

Special Municipal Election March 28, 1939.

The City Council of the City of Sacramento proposes to submit on its own motion to the qualified electors of the City of Sacramento, at a special municipal election to be held in said City of Sacramento on March 28, 1939, the following proposal for the amendment of Section 73 of the Charter of the City of Sacramento, as follows, to wit:

PROPOSAL NO. 1

To amend Section 73 of the Charter of the City of Sacramento as follows:

"FISCAL YEAR

Sec. 73. The City Council is hereby authorized to fix and determine the fiscal year of the City and to change the same from time to time as need may arise."

I hereby certify that the foregoing Charter amendment was ordered submitted by the City Council of the City of Sacramento.

Section 4. The City Clerk of the City of Sacramento is hereby authorized and directed to cause copies of said proposed amendment of said Charter to be printed in convenient pamphlet form and in type of not less than 10 point, and to cause copies of said pamphlet to be mailed to each of the qualified electors of said City, - ~~said pamphlets to be mailed not later than 15 days after the date of adoption of this resolution.~~

Section 5. The City Clerk of the City of Sacramento is hereby ordered and directed upon the printing of said pamphlet setting forth said proposed amendment of said Charter, and until March 28, 1939 (being the date fixed for the election upon such Charter amendment) to publish in The Sacramento Union, the official newspaper of the City of Sacramento (being a newspaper of general circulation published in said City) a notice that copies of said pamphlet may be had at the office of said City Clerk upon application therefor. Such notice may be substantially in the following form:

NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT
TO THE CHARTER OF THE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Sacramento proposes to submit on its own motion to the qualified electors of the City of Sacramento, at a special municipal election to be held March 28, 1939, a proposed amendment to Section 7 3 of the Charter of the City of Sacramento, and that copies of said proposed amendment, in convenient pamphlet form, may be had at the office of the undersigned City Clerk upon application therefor.
