

RESOLUTION APPROVING REPORT AND AMENDED RE-ASSESSMENT NO. 2714

March 2nd, 1950.

WHEREAS, a petition was filed for re-assessment of a certain parcel of land in that certain Street Improvement Proceedings numbered, RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 2714 for the improvement of East Sandburg Drive from the Easterly line of Orchard Terrace Unit No. 2 (as the same is shown on the official Plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder) to the center line of Moddison Avenue; Moddison Avenue from the center line of East Sandburg Drive to the center line of South Sandburg Drive; Right-of-Way owned by the City of Sacramento as contained in deed dated April 15, 1948, recorded May 3rd 1948, in Book No. 1484 of Official Records, Instrument No. 18690 as deeded by Louis D. Carlson and Ada H. Carlson, his wife, and John Sandburg and Minnie E. Sandburg, his wife, to the City of Sacramento, in the City of Sacramento, was filed with the Clerk of the City Council under the provisions of Streets and Highways Code Section 8730 to 8734, and

WHEREAS, the City Council duly and regularly directed that the Superintendent of Streets, re-assess said plat of ground and file his report and amended assessment thereon, and

WHEREAS, the report of FRED J. KLAUS, Superintendent of Streets, and his re-assessment were filed on the 14th day of February, 1950, and

WHEREAS, the Clerk, pursuant to the provisions of said Streets and Highways Code, did duly and regularly give notice of the filing of said Report and the fixing of a time for hearing objections to the Report and the Amended Assessment filed with the City Clerk; and


WHEREAS, all of said matters are now on for hearing at the meeting held this 2nd day of March, 1950, in the Council Chambers of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, and

WHEREAS, no written protests were filed to the same or did anyone appear in person and protest the same,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that notice of this hearing was given in the manner and for the time provided by Law, and that the Report of FRED J. KLAUS, Superintendent of Streets apportioning and re-assessing Assessments Numbers 420, 421, 422 and 424 in Street Improvement Proceedings No. 2714, according to the benefits to be gained by such original street improvement, into 178 (one hundred seventy-eight) parcels, be, and the same is hereby approved and allowed, and that this amended assessment be filed with the City Clerk and the Re-Assessments thereon shall be instead of and in place of the Original Assessments Numbers 420, 421, 422 and 424 as above mentioned.
