SUBJECT: NEW CLASSIFICATION OF ART IN PUBLIC PLACES COORDINATOR

SUMMARY

The Civil Service class of Art in Public Places Coordinator will have responsibility for planning and administering the Art in Public Places Program, which is operated by the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission. Resolutions adding the classification to the General Supervisory Unit and to the salary resolution are attached for adoption by the City Council.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission, which is funded by City, County, and private sources, has several programs, one of which is the Art in Public Places Program. The program was created by City Ordinance and provides for the placement of various media of art in public places such as City buildings, offices, and garages. The art on the City garage across from the Holiday Inn and Macy's is an example of art funded by the program.

The Art in Public Places Coordinator will be responsible for the overall operation and effectiveness of the Art in Public Places Program as specified in the City Ordinance. The work which will be done by the Coordinator is currently being performed on contract by an individual. Funds from public and private sources are expected to provide sufficient money for a vigorous program over the next several years, and it is appropriate from both a fiscal and Civil Service merit system standpoint to have a budgeted position perform the work.

FINANCIAL DATA

The recommended salary range for Art in Public Places Coordinator is \$1863-\$2264 per month. This salary is based on jurisdictions comparable to the City in size of area served and program involved. Local 39 is in agreement with the salary range. The cost of the Coordinator position including salary and benefits for the remainder of the year is approximately \$11,410.
