AWARD CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE SOUTH NATOMAS COMMUNITY CENTER CONCESSION PROJECT (LW32, C13001200)

BACKGROUND

- A. On January 4, 2000, City Council established the South Natomas Community Center project.
- B. On February 7, 2006, City Council approved Resolution No. 2006-104 establishing the CRCIP project list, which included the South Natomas Community Center Concession project.
- C. The formal bid process for the construction of the South Natomas Community Center Concession project was completed on April 16, 2008. Pursuant to City Code Chapter 3.60, Melnikov Construction was determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The construction plans and specifications for the South Natomas Community Center Concession project are approved.
- Section 2. Melnikov Construction is awarded the construction contract for the South Natomas Community Center Concession project in an amount not to exceed \$99,900.
- Section 3. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute the construction contract specified above.
