

# **RESOLUTION NO. 2007-690**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

September 18, 2007

## **HOMELAND SECURITY VOCATIONAL TRAINING FUNDS**

### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The Sacramento Police Department (SPD) entered into a agreement beginning July 1, 2005 (City Agreement No. 2005-1050) to partner with the Los Rios Community College District (LRCCD) for vocational training..
- B. SPD's partnership with LRCCD provides training students with the opportunity to gain college credit and helps offset operating expenses. The SPD runs specific vocational training programs through its Office of Emergency Services and Homeland Security.
- C. Funding for Office of Emergency Services and Homeland Security vocational training requires the addition of a new external funding account to keep monies separate from current Police Academy funds. Pursuant to Resolution 2006-547, the monies received from LRCCD under City Agreement 2005-1050 currently are restricted to the E-894 account.

### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City Manager, or a designated representative, is authorized to receive revenue and make expenditures related to vocational training with the Los Rios Community College District under City Agreement 2005-1050, through the creation of a new external funding account (E-303), in addition to the E-894 account.
- Section 2. Section 2 of Resolution 2006-547 is repealed.
