After award of the contract, the Agency has up to 36 months to complete the construction or vehicle purchase contract.



For State-only funded projects, the date of this allocation is considered the authorization to proceed and is contingent upon execution of a project specific program supplement.

This allocation is not a commitment on the part of the State to make reimbursements until an Administering Agency - State Agreement and a project specific program supplement are executed between the Agency and the State. In addition, for projects receiving federal funds the execution of the Federal-aid Agreement (PR-2) by the State and the Federal Highway Administration is required before reimbursement can occur.
