

RESOLUTION No. 52

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

April 10, 1942

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento has heretofore entered into a contract dated April 27, 1937 for a period of five years, with Frank P. Grech, Philip Fenech, and Antonio Ciapparo, for the collection of wet garbage or swill from the hotels, restaurants, clubs, and hospitals of this City, and

WHEREAS, the price to be paid the City for this contract is based upon a sliding scale depending upon the price of hogs at the San Francisco stockyard, and

WHEREAS, this contract is fair, both to the City and the contractors, and it appears that no better contract could be obtained, and

WHEREAS, said contract is about to expire and should be renewed, and

WHEREAS, Antonio Ciapparo has since died and the interests of his estate have been purchased by the remaining partners,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That said contract be extended for the period of five years with Frank P. Grech and Philip Fenech;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized and directed to make, execute, and deliver an agreement of extension therefor.
