**CERTIFICATION OF NEGATIVE DECLARATION
FOR SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE MERGED DOWNTOWN
SACRAMENTO REDEVELOPMENT PLAN**

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO
DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Agency has considered the Negative Declaration together with any public comments received during the public review process. The Agency hereby finds, on the basis of the whole record before it, that the Negative Declaration is adequate and complete and reflects the independent judgement and analysis of the Agency, and that there is no substantial evidence that the proposed project, the Second Amendment to the Merged Downtown Sacramento Redevelopment Plan will have a significant effect on the environment.

Section 2. The Negative Declaration, in the form attached to this resolution and incorporated in this resolution by this reference, is hereby approved and adopted by the Agency. The Legal Department of the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency, 630 I Street, Sacramento, California, is the custodian of the documents or other materials that constitute the record of proceedings upon which this decision is based.

Section 3. The Executive Director of the Agency is authorized to file a Notice of Determination with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento following the approval of the Second Amendment.
