RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN PACIFIC BELL AND AMERICAN TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH AND THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO FOR FUNDING OF IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE MEASURE A STREET OVERLAY PHASE I 89/90 PROJECT (JN:2054/PN:RC01)

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. That the City Manager and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City of Sacramento Cooperative Agreements with Pacific Bell and American Telephone and Telegraph on the Measure A Street Overlay Phase I 89/90 project.
2. That the 1988/89 revenue budget be amended by increasing revenue to the Capital Grants Fund (248) by \$54,600 from revenue received in accordance with the Cooperative Agreement between Pacific Bell and the City.
3. That the 1988/89 revenue budget be amended by increasing revenue to the Capital Grants Fund (248) by \$4,000 from revenue received in accordance with the Cooperative Agreement between American Telephone and Telegraph and the City.
4. That \$58,600 be appropriated to the Measure A Street Overlay Phase I 89/90 Project (248-500-RC01-4820).

SUBJECT: Measure A Street Overlay Phase I 89/90 (JN:2054) - Cooperative Agreement

SUMMARY

Cooperative Agreements between Pacific Bell, American Telephone and Telegraph and the City of Sacramento to have the City's contractor lower and/or raise Pacific Bell's and American Telephone and Telegraph's manholes during construction of the City's Measure A Street Overlay Phase I 89/90 contract have been reached. Pacific Bell and American Telephone and Telegraph will be billed for the work performed.

BACKGROUND

In the past, contract delays have arisen because of coordination and scheduling difficulties encountered in the lowering and/or raising of existing utility manholes during construction of the City's Street Overlay Program. Specifically, streets which include pavement planing require lowering all manholes prior to the planing process and raising them after the overlay. To minimize these delays, the Engineering Division has developed the attached Cooperative Agreement to have the City's contractor perform the work and the utilities involved reimburse the City.

Generally the utility companies are informed of the streets to be overlaid and the approximate timing of the project. The utilities then make arrangements to have their manholes lowered and/or raised. To improve contract operations it is desirable that the City's contract include the lowering and/or raising of the utility's manholes and the utilities be billed for the work. Pacific Bell and American Telephone and Telegraph have agreed to this process.

FINANCIAL DATA

The estimated cost for work covered by these agreements are \$54,600 for Pacific Bell and \$4,000 for American Telephone and Telegraph. The actual cost for the work will be paid by Pacific Bell and American Telephone and Telegraph. Adjustments to the Capital Improvement Program and Capital Grants Revenue Fund are necessary for accounting purposes.


RECOMMENDATION
