SUMMARY:

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), through the State Department of Transportation (Caltrans), requires that all agencies adopt an annual goal of Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) utilization in all program activities funded wholly or in part by any Federal-Aid transportation monies. The DBE category includes both Minority Business Enterprises (MBE) and Women Business Enterprises (WBE). The Office of Minority, Women and Small Business Enterprise has reviewed and concurs with the adoption of an annual DBE goal of 20%.
